

**CITY OF CARSON
REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 12, 2025 AT 7:30 PM**

Council Present: Rose, Taylor, Richardson. Absent: Graves Richardson. Mayor Houser Present. Staff Present: Hansen, Rose Jr. Public Present: Brett Sherkenbach, Rebecca McClain, Drake Roller.

Mayor Houser called the regular Council meeting to order at 7:30 PM. Pledge of Allegiance. Taylor made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Rose – 3 ayes.

Public Comments: Brett Sherkenbach presented an additional bid for repair work on Christy Street.

Richardson made a motion to approve the Legion to have built and installed cases to display funeral flags in the community center lobby, seconded by Rose – 3 ayes.

Discussion held on 2026 Water Supply Well Professional Services Agreement with Snyder & Associates. Tabled until the June meeting and Council requested a representative from Snyder's attends the meeting.

Discussion was held regarding a 4 way stop at North Commercial and North Street. Tabled until the June meeting.

Discussion was held on the employee handbook. Tabled until the June meeting.

Taylor made a motion to update job descriptions of Public Works Labor I, On Call Seasonal Snow Removal Part Time and Seasonal Mowing/Trimming part time positions to change supervisor from Public Works Supervisor to City Administrator Clerk and/or Mayor, seconded by Richardson, 2 ayes, 1 nay Rose.

Discussion was held on water and sewer rates.

Rose made a motion to have D.A. Davison review proposed water and sewer rates and upon his approval forward to the City Attorney to prepare the ordinance, seconded by Richardson – 3 ayes.

Rose made a motion to approve bid from FMJunk It for \$3,900.00 to remove and dispose of damaged playground equipment in the North area of the Carson Park, seconded by Taylor – 3 ayes.

Rose made a motion to get an appraisal for the city owned dump truck for possible sale, seconded by Taylor – 3 ayes.

City Administrator Report – Discussed Nextlink's lease agreement.

Richardson made a motion to approve the consent agenda, second by Taylor – 3 ayes.

Mayor and Commissioner Reports: Rose discussed the complaints she received about the tree dump accessibility while City Hall was closed.

Taylor made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:14 pm, seconded by Richardson – 3 ayes.
