

ORDINANCE 247

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CARSON, IOWA, BY REPEALING BOTH SUBSECTION 19 AND SUBSECTION 38 OF SECTION 65.01 ENTITLED “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED” AND RE-ADOPTING THE SAME AS REVISED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THREE WAY STOPS AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH STREET AND NORTH LOCUST STREET AND AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH OAK STREET AND WASHINGTON STREET; REPELING ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH CONFLICT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTIONS AMENDED: CHAPTER 65, SUBSECTIONS 19 AND 38 OF SECTION 65.01

BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Carson, Iowa:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Chapter 65, Subsections 19 and 38 of Section 65.01 entitled “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED”.

SECTION 2. SUBSECTION REPEALED AND RE-ADOPTED AS REVISED. Subsection 19 of Section 65.01 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa, is repealed and the following new subsection 19 of Section 65.01 is re-adopted in lieu thereof:

19. At North Street and North Locust Street, traffic from the east, west and northbound shall stop, and traffic will proceed based on the principle that the first vehicle to reach the intersection shall have the right-of-way unless two or more vehicles essentially reach the intersection at the same time. In such cases, the vehicle to the driver’s right shall have the right-of-way.

SECTION 3. SUBSECTION REPEALED AND RE-ADOPTED AS REVISED. Subsection 38 of Section 65.01 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa, is repealed and the following new subsection 38 of Section 65.01 is re-adopted in lieu thereof:

38. At South Oak Street and Washington Street, traffic from the west, north and southbound shall stop, and traffic will proceed based on the principle that the first vehicle to reach the intersection shall have the right-of-way unless two or more vehicles essentially reach the intersection at the same time. In such cases, the vehicle to the driver’s right shall have the right-of-way.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Passed by the Council on second reading the 13 day of September 2021.

Passed by the Council on third reading the 11 day of October 2021 and directions to the City Clerk to publish the Ordinance as approved.
