

ORDINANCE 271

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CARSON, IOWA, BY REPEALING SUBSECTION 16 OF SECTION 65.01 ENTITLED “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED” OF CHAPTER 65 AND RE-ADOPTING THE SAME AS REVISED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A FOUR WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH STREET AND NORTH COMMERCIAL STREET; BY REPEALING SUBSECTION 17 OF SECTION 65.01 ENTITLED “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED” OF CHAPTER 65 TO ELIMINATE DUPLICATE PROVISIONS; BY REPEALING SUBSECTION 32 OF SECTION 65.01 ENTITLED “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED” OF CHAPTER 65 AND RE-ADOPTING THE SAME AS REVISED TO CORRECT THE NAME OF ONE OF THE STREETS REFERENCED THEREIN; BY REPEALING SUBSECTION 38 OF SECTION 65.01 ENTITLED “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED” OF CHAPTER 65 AND RE-ADOPTING THE SAME AS REVISED TO CORRECT ONE OF THE DIRECTIONS OF TRAVEL OF TRAFFIC WHICH MUST STOP; FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH CONFLICT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Carson, Iowa:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Chapter 65, by amending Subsection 16 of Section 65.01 entitled “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED”, by repealing Subsection 17 of Section 65.01 entitled “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED” and inserting nothing in place of Subsection 17, by amending Subsection 28 of Section 65.01 entitled “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED”, by amending Subsection 32 of Section 65.01 entitled “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED” an by amending Subsection 38 of Section 65.01 entitled “STOP LOCATIONS DESIGNATED”.

SECTION 2. SECTION 3. SUBSECTION REPEALED AND RE-ADOPTED AS REVISED. Subsection 16 of Section 65.01 of Chapter 65 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa, is repealed and the following new Subsection 16 of Section 65.01 of Chapter 65 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa is re-adopted in lieu thereof: 16. At North Street and North Commercial Street, all traffic shall stop, and traffic will proceed based on the principle that the first vehicle to reach the intersection shall have the right-of-way unless two or more vehicles essentially reach the intersection at the same time. In such cases, the vehicle to the driver’s right shall have the right-of-way.

SECTION 3. SUBSECTION REPEALED. Subsection 17 of Section 65.01 of Chapter 65 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa, is repealed and no new subsection is re-adopted in lieu thereof.

SECTION 4. SUBSECTION REPEALED AND RE-ADOPTED AS REVISED. Subsection 32 of Section 65.01 of Chapter 65 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa, is repealed and the following new Subsection 32 of Section 65.01 of Chapter 65 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa is re-adopted in lieu thereof: 32. At South Central Street and Vine Street, traffic approaching from the east and west on Vine Street shall stop, and traffic on South Central shall have the right shall have the right-of-way.

SECTION 5. SUBSECTION REPEALED AND RE-ADOPTED AS REVISED. Subsection 38 of Section 65.01 of Chapter 65 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa, is repealed and the following new Subsection 38 of Section 65.01 of Chapter 65 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Carson, Iowa is re-adopted in lieu thereof: 38. At South Oak Street and Washington Street, traffic from the west, north and south shall stop, and traffic will proceed based on the principle that the first vehicle to reach the intersection shall have the right-of-way unless two or more vehicles essentially reach the intersection at the same time. In such cases, the vehicle to the driver’s right shall have the right-of-way.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 7. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
